# **FINAL PROGRAMME**

Goa is a small state with high literacy and GDP of near 3500\$. The economy is however in the primary and value add stage, be it in manufacture or services sector. Goa needs to move from 30% graduate enrollment to emulate Korea with 90% graduate enrollment with matching abilities.
